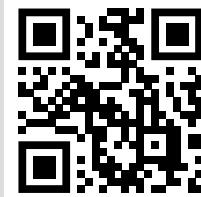

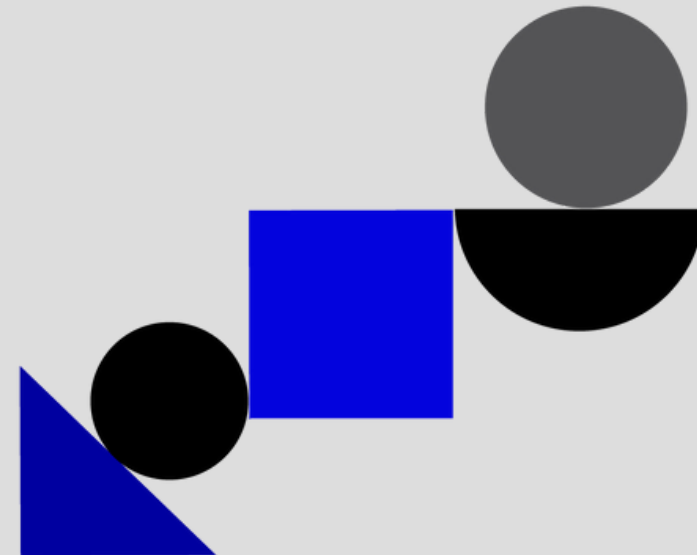

LOST2 project is funded by the Erasmus+ Programme and gathers nine partners from six EU countries, which will work together until May 2025, to develop an array of results, including a new professional profile / Qualification associated to the missing people research.

- 02 Preparatory dossier for the formal recognition of the Qualification in the EU countries represented by LOST2 consortium.
- 03 LOST2 Platform, the focal point of a Community of Practice (CoP), where LOST2 Partners, VET Providers and other national and European institutions and associations working with the Missing People phenomenon, can share experiences and network.



Aims

- Analyse, share, enrich and define the Consultant in Information Analysis and Research of Missing Persons Qualification.
- Prepare the required documentation, in line with the European standards, to allow National Qualification Agencies to proceed with the verification, validation and recognition of the Qualification.
- Lay the foundations for a future equivalence of the Qualification in Europe, considering the standards re-quired by recent EU guidelines, to foster a valid certification across the EU.
- Expand employment opportunities of Consultant in Information Analysis and Research of Missing Persons professionals, by guaranteeing the usability of the Qualification and its transferability into all EU countries.
